



## **LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE** **29 August 2007**

### **Almonte:**

- 1) On the 26<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 police were notified that an audible alarm could be heard at a business located on Mill Street. Police attended the scene and based on descriptions obtained arrested and charged an adult male for mischief after it was determined rocks had been thrown at the property and damage had occurred. A great example of reporting a suspicious occurrence with a positive end result.
- 2) On the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 two mailboxes were reported vandalized on Country Street in the vicinity of Argyle Street. The incidents occurred between the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of August 2007.

### **Beckwith Township:**

- 1) A trailer located at a property on Townline Road West (at town limits of Carleton Place) was reported broken into on the 24<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The incident occurred between the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 and involved the door to the trailer being pried open. No items were reported stolen.

### **Carleton Place:**

- 1) A vehicle was reported entered overnight on the 21<sup>st</sup> of August 2007 and a wallet stolen. The incident occurred on Elizabeth Street.
- 2) A 10 lb and two 5 lb Flag fire extinguishers were stolen at a residential property on Franklin Street. The theft was reported on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2007.
- 3) A billboard sign was reported damaged on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 at a business property on McNeely Avenue. The damage occurred the previous week and it was reported that it appeared the sign had been run over. The sign is situated on McNeely Avenue.
- 4) Between the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 a bicycle left unlocked at a school property on Lake Avenue West was stolen. The item is described as a 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Edition Canadian Tire bicycle.

### **Central Frontenac Township:**

- 1) Between the 14<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 an incident of mischief occurred at a residential property on Nelson Road (runs south off of Highway 7, just east of the Sharbot Lake Provincial Park). The mischief consisted of throwing metal lawn chairs and a table around the yard, pulling down a bird feeder, and throwing a decorative metal wagon wheel a top a hydro line. This was reported to police on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August 2007.
- 2) A boat motor was reported stolen from a boat on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August 2007 at a residential property on Oconto Camp Road at Eagle Lake (runs west off of Road 38, south of Sharbot Lake). The item is described as a 15 horsepower Honda 4 stroke boat motor.
- 3) Two windows were reported vandalized (broken) at a church located in Arden on the 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The damage occurred between the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2007.
- 4) Several mailboxes were reported vandalized on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The incidents occurred on Fall River Road (runs south off of Highway 7, east of Sharbot Lake) and on Zealand Road at Sharbot Lake. The vandalism occurred between the 24<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. A residence was also struck with eggs at approximately 12:10 a.m. on the 27<sup>th</sup> just south of Sharbot Lake on Road 38.

### **North Frontenac Township:**

- 1) A vehicle left unattended at a boat launch at Red Horse Lake on Arcol Road (runs off of Canonto Road, north of Ompah) was reported broken into on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August 2007. The theft took place the previous week at which time several items were stolen. The stolen items include a tackle box containing a GPS Magellan Explorist 210, approx. 90 lures, 50 spinners, and a Stihl 034-AV chainsaw. A 9 foot Fendwick Flyrod, and two six foot Ugly Stick fishing rods with Ukuma reels were also stolen.

### **Drummond/North Elmsley Township:**

- 1) A residence on Poonamalie Road (runs south of Hwy 43, west of Smiths Falls) was reported broken into on the 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. Several items were reported stolen. No further details available at this time.
- 2) An A.T.V (All Terrain Vehicle was reported stolen from a residential property on Code Road in the vicinity of Tennyson Road (runs north off of Tennyson Road, northeast of Perth) on the 20<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The stolen item is described as a

2005 white and red Yamaha A.T.V. and was stolen between the 16<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of August 2007.

- 3) A mailbox was reported vandalized on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2007. The incident took place on Fergusons Falls Road (runs east off of Hwy 511 north of Balderson) in the vicinity of McIlquham Blair Road at approximately 4:30 a.m.
- 4) A wrench was reported thrown through a window on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2007 at a business property located on Highway 511 at Balderson. The incident occurred overnight.

**Lanark Highlands Township:**

- 1) A crossbow was reported stolen from a residential property on Snye Road in the area of White Lake (northwest of Pakenham). The crossbow described as an Excaliber with a scope and arrows and was stolen between 06:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the 27<sup>th</sup>.

**Montague Township:**

- 1) A whipper snipper and a gas can were reported stolen from a shed located at the St. Francis cemetery on Highway 15, north of Smiths Falls. The items were stolen from the shed between the 24<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007.

**Mississippi Mills Township:**

No incidents to report.

**Tay Valley Township:**

- 1) An inflatable raft moored on Big Rideau Lake was reported stolen on the 20<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The raft was stolen overnight from a residential property located on Big Rideau North Shore Road and is described as a blue and grey Aqua Glide inflatable raft.
- 2) A residence was struck with eggs on the 21<sup>st</sup> of August 2007 at approximately 12:10 a.m. at a property on Bathurst Upper Fourth Concession in the vicinity of Cameron Side Road north of Dewitts Corners, west of Perth. A vehicle (no description obtained) was observed leaving the scene.
- 3) The screen in a door was discovered cut on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2007. The incident occurred at a property on Farren Lake Lane 12 (runs off of Hanna Road at Christie Lake). No entry however was made inside the residence.
