



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
22 February 2007

Almonte:

- 1) A passer-by reported observing a door open at a residence on Jamieson Street on the 15th of February 2007 at 11:45 a.m. Police attended and it was determined the wind had blown the door open. A good example of reporting suspicious activity.

Beckwith Township:

- 1) A business located on Highway 15 in the vicinity of the 10th Line Beckwith (south of Carleton Place) reported the theft of several items on the 17th of February 2007. The theft took place within the previous week. Reported stolen are; a red 2006 Honda EU2000 generator, a red 2006 Honda HS520C 5 horsepower snow blower, and a black 2006 Polaris 700 snowmobile (limited edition with windshield).
- 2) On the 20th of February 2007 a suspicious vehicle was reported to police. The incident occurred on the 17th of February 2007 between 8:05 p.m. and 8:20 p.m. when a vehicle was observed pulling into a laneway on Windmill Crescent (runs south off of Richmond Road at Prospect) and sitting there. The vehicle drove away upon a neighbour approaching it. The vehicle is described as a yellow Chevrolet Cavalier with a rear spoiler.
- 3) A snowmobile was reported stolen on the 22nd of February 2007. The incident took place at approximately 5:00 a.m. on the 22nd at a property on Catherine Avenue (just north of Lake Park Road, southwest of Carleton Place). Fresh tracks indicate the suspect drove the snowmobile through the Carlbeck golf course in the direction of the 10th Line Beckwith. The stolen item is described as a black 2003 Polaris S03 and was plated with an Ontario plate of 938684 at the time of the theft.

Carleton Place:

- 1) On the 17th of February 2007 a vehicle was reported “egged” overnight. The incident occurred at a residence on Bridge Street.
- 2) On the 17th of February 2007 the front window of a business was reported broken overnight. The damage occurred at a business property located on Bridge Street.
- 3) On the 18th of February 2007 a break and enter was reported. The incident occurred between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on the 16th of February 2007 at a residence on Doucett Drive. Entry was gained through an unlocked door at which time a grey portable DVD player was stolen.
- 4) A vehicle was reported entered over the weekend on the 19th of February 2007. The incident occurred on Lake Park Road at which time a small quantity of change, a gas card, and the front licence plate was stolen from the vehicle.

Central Frontenac Township:

- 1) A shack at an outdoor rink located on Mountain Grove Road just south of Highway 7 near Bradley Road was reported damaged on the 16th of February 2007. The damage occurred overnight and consisted of a window being broken, and several wires connecting light timers being tampered with.

North Frontenac Township:

- 1) The Trout Lake Hotel located on County Road 509 in Ompah was reported broken into overnight on the 18th of February 2007. Entry was made by forcing a window at which time a quantity of cash was stolen from a cash box.

Drummond/North Elmsley Township:

- 1) A suspicious vehicle incident was reported to police on the 15th of February 2007 having occurred at approximately 1:00 p.m. A pickup truck with a trailer carrying a snowmobile was observed on Drummond Concession 11 (west of Scotch Corners, runs off of Ebbs Bay Road) in front of a residence with the occupants taking pictures of the property. The vehicle is described as a late 1980’s model extended cab, and had two white males inside, one being described as bald. The vehicle appeared to leave the scene upon observing someone home at the residence.

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) On the 18th of February 2007 at 4:50 a.m. Lanark County OPP attended a property on 9th Concession B Dalhousie (runs north off of Watsons Corners Road, Purdons Bay area) in response to an alarm. Upon arrival fresh footprints were observed in the snow leading to a garage which was found closed. The footprints were followed leading to the tracks of a vehicle a few meters up the road. No items were reported stolen from the garage.
- 2) On the 21st of February 2007 a residence located on Snye Road (3 Mile Bay area, between Love's Gate and Lakeshore Road) was reported broken into. Several items were stolen. No further details at this time.
