



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
02 July 2007

Almonte:

- 1) The window of a business was reported spray-painted overnight on the 28th of June 2007. The incident occurred on Mill Street.

Beckwith Township:

- 1) On the 28th of June 2007 an attempt break and enter occurred at a residence on the 10th Line Beckwith (west of Hwy 15, south of Carleton Place, runs east/west through Hwy 15). The incident occurred between 10:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the 28th where several basement window screens were removed. No entry was made into the residence.
- 2) During daylight hours on the 28th of June 2007 a residence on the 10th Line Beckwith (nearby above residence) was broken into. Entry into the residence was made via a window at which time the residence was rummaged through. No items however were reported stolen.
- 3) A mailbox was reported damaged overnight on the 30th of June 2007. The mailbox appeared to have been struck by a vehicle on Glenashton Road in the vicinity of Campbell's Side Road (runs east/west through Derry Side Road east of Blacks Corners) and was located in a ditch across the street.

Carleton Place:

- 1) On the 28th of June 2007 several window screens in the common area of an apartment building were reported vandalized overnight. The incident occurred at an apartment building located on Sussex Street.
- 2) A garage located on William Street was reported broken into on the 29th of June 2007 at approximately 3:35 a.m. when the property owner discovered two males inside the garage. The two males then fled the scene in the direction of Bridge Street. They are both described as being approx. 19 years of age, and 5'10" in height, wearing ball caps. One is described as wearing a red baseball jersey with the second male wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt.

- 3) On the 29th of June 2007 between 01:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. a garage was entered on Bell Street via a window. No items were reported stolen.
- 4) A vehicle was reported vandalized overnight on the 29th of June 2007. The incident occurred on Bridge Street and involved damage to the wipers, and a dent being left in the side of the vehicle.
- 5) A suspicious person was reported to police on the 29th of June 2007 at a residence on Sarah Street. A male was located on the back porch at approximately 9:50 p.m. by the property owner. The male then fled through the rear door exiting the porch (literally through the door, breaking glass). He is described as wearing black shorts with a black fleece sweater, six feet in height with short hair and was carrying a black backpack at the time of the incident.
- 6) Some time between midnight and 10:00 a.m. on the 30th of June 2007 a passenger van was damaged on Emily Street. A side mirror was torn off and a mark was left on the front bumper.
- 7) A generator was reported stolen from the rear of a pickup truck in a parking lot located on McNeely Avenue. The incident took place on the 30th of June 2007 at approximately 12:05 p.m. when the owner returned to his vehicle and observed a male removing a cooler from the pickup truck. The male then fled the scene in a vehicle described as a silver Dodge Sebring with an Alberta plate.

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) Between the 21st and 29th of June 2007 a chain across a driveway was removed from a property on Fairs Lane (runs east off the 8th Concession Dalhousie, north of McDonalds Corners). No entry was made into the residence, and no further property damage was reported.

- 2) On the 29th of June 2007 a boat motor was reported stolen from a property on Windy Point Road (runs north off of Pickeral Bay at White Lake, northwest of Pakenham). The item is described as a black 2006 Mercury 15 horsepower outboard motor that was stolen some time prior to June 29th 2007.

Montague Township:

No incidents to report.

Mississippi Mills Township:

- 1) On the 29th of June 2007 a mischief involving a mailbox was reported to police. The incident occurred on Quarry Road in the vicinity of Ramsay Concession 6A (runs north out of Carleton Place) in which a firecracker was placed in a mailbox and lit. The explosion left residue in the mailbox but did not damage it. The incident is believed to have occurred at approx. 12:30 a.m. on the 29th when the property owner heard a loud bang.

Tay Valley Township:

- 1) A set of community mailboxes were reported tipped over and damaged at the intersection of Stanleyville Road and Powers Road (south of Stanleyville, southwest of Perth). The incident was reported on the 30th of June 2007.
