



**LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE**  
**10 July 2007**

**Almonte:**

- 1) The lock to a storage shed was discovered tampered with on the 08<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 at the Almonte and District High School located on Martin Street North. It has yet to be determined if any items were stolen from the shed.

**Beckwith Township:**

No incidents to report.

**Carleton Place:**

- 1) Between the 06<sup>th</sup> and 09<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 a toy train located at a daycare center on Coleman Street was moved causing some damage.

**Central Frontenac Township:**

- 1) A dairy located on Wagarville Road at Parham was broken into between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 overnight. Entry was made by prying a door at which time a grease gun was removed from the building and used to spread grease on a delivery truck. The grease gun was located nearby, and no further items were reported stolen.

**North Frontenac Township:**

No incidents to report.

**Drummond/North Elmsley Township:**

- 1) A boat and a trailer were stolen between the 07<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 from a rest stop at Innisville, Ontario. The items are described as a 1979 Crestline Rampage boat with the words "Boyz Toy" on the back. It is white with burnt orange accents and is 26 feet long. The motor attached is a 260 HP Mercury 5.7 litre inboard/outboard motor. The boat trailer is a white colored two-axle trailer with hydraulic brakes and was plated with Ontario plate D8508X at the time of the theft. The items had been left at this location due to the brakes malfunctioning on the trailer.

**Lanark Highlands Township:**

- 1) A quantity of copper wire valued at approximately \$1500.00 was reported stolen on the 09<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 from a property on George Street in the Village of Lanark. The wire is believed to have been stolen between the 07<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of July 2007.

**Montague Township:**

- 1) A mailbox was reported vandalized overnight on the 09<sup>th</sup> of July 2007. The incident occurred on Rosedale Road North (runs north off of Roger Stevens Drive, east of Smiths Falls) in the vicinity of MacPherson Road. The complainant indicated several others were also damaged in the area.  
A report of a small grey car in the area at approximately 11:25 p.m. was made on the 08<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 and may be related. The report was of 3-4 youth inside the car attempting to smash a mailbox.

**Mississippi Mills Township:**

- 1) An A.T.V (All Terrain Vehicle) was stolen between the 07<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 from a property on Gemmill Street in Clayton. The item had been stored outside on the property and is described as a 2006 Yamaha 450 CC white in color.
- 2) A front window of a residence was discovered damaged on the 09<sup>th</sup> of July 2007. The damage consisted of a hole in the window possibly made by a pellet gun. The incident occurred at a residence on Clayton Road (runs west off of County Road 29, north of Almonte). The exact time frame for when the damage occurred is not known.

**Tay Valley Township:**

- 1) A residence located on Fallbrook Road (southwest of Lanark, runs south off of McDonalds Corners Road) was broken into between 8:45 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on the 06<sup>th</sup> of July 2007. Entry was made through an insecure door at which time several items were rifled through, however no items were reported stolen.
