



**LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE**  
**18 June 2007**

**Almonte:**

- 1) An unknown vandal broke a garage window on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 during the afternoon hours. The incident occurred at a property on Reserve Street.

**Beckwith Township:**

No incidents to report.

**Carleton Place:**

- 1) Police attended Mill Street at the train bridge on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 6:35 p.m. in regard to youth swimming at this location. The youth left when warned regarding trespassing and the dangers involved. Parents / guardians are encouraged to speak to their children/teens regarding water safety, and the dangers that are present when swimming in areas not designated for swimmers. Similar occurrences have occurred in other areas in Lanark County including the Village of Lanark where youth are swimming near dams etc.
- 2) A patio table was reported broken to police on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 after it was discovered a bottle had been thrown at it smashing the glass. The incident occurred on the 08<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at a property on Sinclair Avenue.
- 3) Between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 a window of a front door was vandalized (smashed) with an alcohol bottle. The incident took place at a business property on Bridge Street.
- 4) On the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 12:50 a.m. a suspicious person was reported to police. The incident occurred on Rosamond Street where a male was reported attempting to enter a residence and then left the scene. Police attended the area and identified three youth.
- 5) Two lamp poles located at a business property on Lake Street were reported vandalized overnight on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007.

### **Central Frontenac Township:**

- 1) On the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 a 5 horsepower Honda outboard motor and a plastic gas can were reported stolen from a garage on Brewer Road (runs west off Road 38 south of Sharbot Lake). The theft took place between January and May 2007.
- 2) Marine Update: Big Clear Lake was patrolled on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. Two boaters were charged for failing to have necessary equipment on board.

### **North Frontenac Township:**

- 1) Marine Update: Brule Lake was patrolled on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. A boater was charged with failing to have a sound signalling device.
- 2) On the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 a theft of several items from a shed was reported to police. The theft took place some time within the previous week at a property on County Road 506 in the vicinity of Farm Lake Lane, south of Ardoch. Stolen were the following items; 2006 push lawnmower, dark green 2006 Yardworks riding lawnmower and a small utility trailer that attaches to the riding lawnmower.
- 3) On the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at approx. 11:20 p.m. two four wheelers were reported having damaged a driveway on Mosque Lake Road just north of Road 509 (west of Ompah). The four wheelers are described as being red and the second one yellow. The driver of the red one had a beard or goatee with sunglasses, and a black helmet.
- 4) Marine Update: Big Gull Lake was patrolled on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. A boater was charged with having an insufficient number of life jackets on board, and being in possession of open alcohol.
- 5) Marine Update: Kashwakamak Lake was patrolled on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. Four boaters were charged with failing to have necessary equipment on board, and a fifth boater was charged with being in possession of open alcohol.

### **Drummond/North Elmsley Township:**

- 1) A socket set was stolen between the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 from a shed located on Mazie Street (runs off of Hwy 43 just west of Smiths Falls). Entry into the shed was made by removing a window screen.

### **Lanark Highlands Township:**

- 1) On the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 mischief incidents were reported to police having occurred within the last two to three weeks at the Timber Run Golf Course at the south end of the Village of Lanark. Golf carts were reported driven around the course damaging the greens, and several port-a-potties were vandalized. In one incident a golf cart was taken from the course and later recovered in the river in Lanark.
- 2) On the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 a boat and two trailers were reported stolen from a property on Cedardale Lane (runs south off of Bow Lake Road, north of Hopetown. No further details available at this time.
- 3) On the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 the driver's side window and ignition of a GMC pickup was reported vandalized overnight. The incident took place on Rosetta Road in the vicinity of the 5<sup>th</sup> Concession A Lanark just northeast of the Village of Lanark.

### **Montague Township:**

- 1) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 10:30 a.m. Two males were reported in a red pickup truck sitting stationary at Nolan's Road and Rosedale Road N, northeast of Smiths Falls. Police attended locating the vehicle and identified the occupants.
- 2) A suspicious person report was made to police on the 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 10:15 a.m. when several males were reported being at the flea market on Roger Stevens Drive at the east town limits of Smiths Falls while the facility was closed. Police attended and it was determined to be construction workers working on the building. A good job of neighbours looking out for neighbours!
- 3) A green and yellow 22 horsepower John Deere L130 lawn tractor was reported stolen overnight on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. The lawn tractor was stolen from the back yard of a property on Code Drive (west of Nolans Corners in the vicinity of Rosedale Road North).

### **Mississippi Mills Township:**

- 1) An A.T.V (All Terrain Vehicle) was reported stolen to police on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 from a property on County Road 29 just north of Almonte. The A.T.V was stolen from a locked shed between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2007. The item is described as a green and black 2004 Arctic Cat DVX 400. The A.T.V was not plated at the time of the theft.
- 2) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 1:10 a.m. A vehicle described as a white truck with a burnt out headlight was reported driving in and out a driveway at a property located on 5<sup>th</sup> Concession N. Pakenham (runs south off Campbell Side Road, northwest of Pakenham). Police patrolled the area with negative results.
- 3) A set of golf clubs was stolen some time after 2:00 p.m. from a vehicle on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at the Pakenham golf course located on McWatty Road (south of Pakenham).
- 4) On the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 the rope cordoning golf carts to a specific area was reported cut overnight. This occurred at the Mississippi Mills Golf Course on Wilson Street just west of Appleton. The golf carts were checked and did not appear to have sustained any damage.

### **Tay Valley Township:**

- 1) A suspicious person was reported to police on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2007 at 11:00 p.m. The incident took place at a property on Althorpe Road east of Crosby Road (south side of Christie Lake, south of Maberly area) where a man attended a residence asking for food at approx. 10:45 p.m. The man was told to leave at which time he complied leaving on a bicycle in the direction of Westport. He was described as a white male, 6' 4", 240 lbs, short brown military style haircut, no facial hair wearing a long sleeved black dress shirt, blue jeans, and black shoes.
