



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
21 June 2007

Almonte:

- 1) A window in a door at Naismith P.S on King Street was reported damaged on the 19th of June 2007. The damage consisted of the glass in the door sustaining a large crack after it appeared to have been struck by a golf ball. Several golf balls were located on the roof of the school and on the ground nearby. The damage is believed to have occurred over the weekend between the 15th and 18th of June 2007.
- 2) At approximately 11:00 p.m. on the 19th of June 2007 residents on Queen Street were alerted to a loud noise outside and upon investigation discovered the passenger side mirror of a car had been vandalized. A tall male wearing a white shirt and dark shorts was observed walking away from the scene northbound towards Martin Street.

Beckwith Township:

No incidents to report.

Carleton Place:

- 1) A car described as being a small sized dark coloured import was reported shooting paintballs at vehicles on Joseph Street on the 18th of June 2007 at approximately 10:35 p.m. One vehicle was struck twice. The suspect vehicle was last observed turning onto High Street.
- 2) A vehicle was reported egged on the 18th of June 2007 on Lake Avenue East in the vicinity of Carmel Street. The incident occurred at approximately 10:30 p.m. on the 18th.

- 3) A wallet was stolen from a parked vehicle on Landsdowne Street on the 18th of June 2007 during daylight hours. The vehicle had only been left unattended for a short period of time when the theft took place. A reminder never to leave valuables unattended in your vehicle even for a short period of time. Though credit cards can be easily cancelled, replacing I.D such as health cards, S.I.N. cards, and driver's licenses can be a time consuming and lengthy process. When traveling leave pieces of I.D that are not necessary to have with you, at home.
- 4) Between the 16th and 18th of June 2007 two bicycles were reported stolen from a shed on Beckwith Street. The bicycles are described as being Norco Sasquatch bikes with one being dark purple in colour and the second being gold coloured.
- 5) A white Dodge pickup truck was discovered abandoned in a parking lot on Mullet Street on the 19th of June 2007. The vehicle which was outstanding as stolen from Smiths Falls had been parked in a visitor parking space for a few days

Central Frontenac Township:

- 1) A marine battery was reported stolen on the 20th of June 2007 from a property on Road 38 at Sharbot Lake. The battery had been outside on a table and was stolen within a few days prior to it being reported stolen.

North Frontenac Township:

- 1) Marine Update: A boater was charged with impaired operation of a vessel on the 15th of June 2007 after being stopped on Crotch Lake by a member of the O.P.P S.A.V.E unit (Snowmobile, A.T.V, Vessel Enforcement).
- 2) A Ford Ranger pickup truck reported stolen on the 16th of June 2007 from a business property on County Road 509 at Palmerston Lake was later recovered abandoned on Mosque Lake Road (runs north off of 509) just west from where it was stolen. The vehicle was recovered on the 20th of June 2007.

Drummond/North Elmsley Township:

- 1) A storage trailer was reported broken into on the 15th of June 2007 at a property on Port Elmsley Road in the vicinity of Jodi Lane Road (south of Highway 43 at Port Elmsley). A 14" circular saw and a survey transit were reported stolen. No further details at this time.

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) A gas tank was reported stolen from a boat on the 18th of June 2007. The incident occurred at a property on Dalhousie Lake north of McDonald's Corners. No further details available at this time as to the exact location
- 2) A utility trailer was reported stolen on the 19th of June 2007. The trailer described as a tandem landscaper trailer, 16 feet long by 8 feet 6 inches was stolen between April and June 2007 from a property just south of South Lavant Road in the vicinity of Bottle Lake Road (west of Lavant).

Montague Township:

- 1) Three laptops were reported stolen overnight from an educational facility located on Rosedale Road North south of Nolan's Road (east of Smiths Falls) on the 18th of June 2007. Entry was made into the building through a window.

Mississippi Mills Township:

- 1) A Dodge pickup truck stolen from Ottawa on the 17th of June 2007 was recovered on the 20th of June 2007 parked on Tatlock Road in the vicinity of Miller Road (south of Clayton). It appeared to have been abandoned there for a while.
