



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE **21 November 2007**

Almonte:

- 1) A residence on Maude Street was struck by eggs and paintballs on the 17th of November 2007 between 5:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. The incident was reported to police on the 18th of November 2007. Though there was no permanent damage, there was clean up involved.

Beckwith Township:

- 1) On the 18th of November 2007 a very disturbing discovery was made at a park and ride parking lot located on Highway 7 at Cemetery Side Road, east of Carleton Place. Six deceased cats that appeared to have met an untimely death by physical force were located on and around a vehicle which had been left in the parking unattended between 6:15 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. on the 18th. The owner of the vehicle was spoken to and the fact that this vehicle may have been targeted randomly has not been ruled out. A reminder that anyone with information regarding this incident or any others is encouraged to contact police or contact Crime Stoppers should you wish to remain anonymous.

Carleton Place:

- 1) A passenger car was reported damaged overnight on the 17th of November 2007. The unattended car had been left parked in a parking lot at Bridge and Franklin Street where it appears someone kicked the passenger side front door leaving a dent.
- 2) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 19th of November 2007 at 8:15 p.m. after a passenger car was observed at Townline Road in the vicinity of William Street sitting stationary for over ½ an hour with two occupants inside. Police attended the scene and ascertained the occupants were waiting for someone. A good example of reporting suspicious activity.
- 3) On the 19th of November 2007 a vehicle was reported stolen from a business property located on Highway 7 at Carleton Place. The stolen vehicle is a 1992 Honda Civic SI, purple in color. The vehicle was not plated at the time of the theft which occurred within the previous two days. At the time of this report it is still outstanding as stolen.
- 4) On the 19th of November 2007 police received a report of damage to a door which occurred overnight. The incident took place to an apartment door located at Allan Street. It is believed someone kicked the door causing minor damage.

- 5) Two vending machines were reported damaged, and approximately \$48.00 stolen from the machines on the 20th of November 2007. The incident occurred at the Carleton Place High School located on Lake Avenue West. The exact time frame for the theft is not known.

Central Frontenac Township:

No incidents to report.

Drummond/North Elmsley Township:

- 1) A mailbox was reported destroyed on the 17th of November 2007. The incident occurred on Ebert Road (runs between Drummond Concession 1 and 2, east of Perth) between 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the 16th of November 2007. It appears the mailbox was struck by a vehicle which then left the scene. A section of a headlight was left behind.
- 2) Update: In a previous Neighbourhood Watch update a trailer was reported broken into on the 09th of September 2007 and involved the theft of adult related movies and items. The incident took place on Richmond's Road which runs off of Highway 7 just east of Perth at Wayside. As of November three youth have been identified as responsible for the break and enter and have been diverted through the Lanark County Community Justice Program. FYI.
- 3) On the 20th of November 2007 feces were discovered smeared on the front steps and the door handles at the Drummond Central Public School located on Drummond School Road, east of Perth. The incident is believed to have occurred overnight.

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) On the 17th of November 2007 police were advised that the gate lock had been cut and the waste site located on Snye Road (between Peneshula and 3 Mile Bay Road, northwest of Pakenham) entered. It is believed that the person(s) who broke in were illegally dumping garbage. An exact time frame for when this incident took place is not known, but it is believed to have occurred during daylight hours on the 17th of November 2007.

Montague Township:

- 1) An attempt theft of an A.T.V and a dirt bike overnight was reported to police on the 19th of November 2007. Locks on the garage and a second outbuilding were cut off the buildings to gain entry, at which time the A.T.V was removed from inside. Both vehicles had the gas lines cut however were left behind.
- 2) A business property located on Lorne Street at the southern town limits of Smiths Falls was reported broken into overnight on the 18th of November 2007. Entry inside was made by forcing a door. No further details at this time.
