



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
31 October 2007

Almonte:

- 1) On the 24th of October 2007 a vehicles tires were reported slashed. The incident was discovered on the 21st of October 2007 at a residential property on Water Street.
- 2) Youth were reported throwing apples at vehicles on Ottawa Street on the 24th of October 2007 at 8:20 p.m.
- 3) A Cadillac hood emblem was reported stolen from a car on the 29th of October 2007. The theft occurred on King Street over the previous weekend.
- 4) On the 27th of October 2007 at 8:15 p.m. police were advised by a passing motorist that several youth were throwing eggs in the area of Gemmill Park. Police attended the scene and as a result three youth were located and charged with possession of marijuana and alcohol. A great example of reporting a minor suspicious activity that turned out to be more.
- 5) On the 27th of October 2007 two windows were reported vandalized (broken by rocks) at a property on Main Street West in the vicinity of Mill Street West. The vandalism occurred between the 26th and 27th of October 2007.
- 6) A bicycle was reported stolen on the 30th of October 2007. The bicycle described as a maroon CCM Axe-1 had been chained to a fence at the Almonte District High School and was discovered stolen at 3:00 p.m.

Beckwith Township:

- 1) A fence was reported vandalized overnight on the 25th of October 2007 at a pasture field located on the 9th Line Beckwith in the vicinity of Derry Side Road (east of Blacks Corners, southeast of Carleton Place). The fence was cut in two places, and a portion of electric fence wire was also cut.
- 2) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 28th of October 2007 at 12:20 a.m. The vehicle is described as being a 4 door older model and was observed parked near a residence with its lights out. It then left the scene traveling westbound. The incident occurred on Hemlock Drive (runs off of Cemetery Side Road just south of Highway 7, southeast of Carleton Place).

Carleton Place:

- 1) A vehicle was reported vandalized on the 26th of October 2007. The damage occurred between the 24th and 25th of October 2007 to a passenger car parked at a residence on Knox Street. The damage consisted of the vehicle's sides being "keyed" and the letters "FU" keyed onto the hood.
- 2) A wallet and cell phone were reported stolen from a knapsack on the 26th of October 2007. The theft occurred at the Carleton Place H.S on Lake Avenue West while the knapsack was left unattended in a locker room at approximately 9:00 p.m. on the 26th.
- 3) A vehicle was reported entered overnight on the 28th of October 2007. The incident occurred at a residential property on Elizabeth Street. The unlocked car was entered and a wallet inside stolen.

Central Frontenac Township:

- 1) On the 25th of October 2007 the canteen at the Sharbot Lake ball diamond located at Road 38 in Sharbot Lake was reported vandalized. The damage consisted of the door being forced, the windows broken and areas spray painted. The damage is estimated at approximately \$500.00 and occurred within the previous two days.

North Frontenac Township:

- 1) On the 29th of October 2007 eleven stainless steel solar lights valued at \$150.00 were reported stolen from a residential property on Arcol Road (runs off of Canonto Road off of Road 509, north of Ompah). The theft occurred between the 15th and 25th of October 2007.

Drummond/North Elmsley Township:

Montague Township:

- 1) Seven solar lights were reported stolen overnight from a residential property at Rideau Avenue South (located at the east Smiths Falls town limits) on the 29th of October 2007. The solar lights are described as three of them being black spikes, two lantern style, and two that flashed on and off. This same property was also subject to a break and enter that occurred on the 27th of October 2007 at approximately 10:00 p.m. when several youth were observed removing a lock from a barn. The youth fled the scene without removing any items from the barn after a nearby resident approached them.
- 2) A flea market located on Roger Stevens Drive in the vicinity of Code Drive, east of Smiths Falls was reported broken into overnight on the 24th of October 2007. No further details available at this time.

Mississippi Mills Township:

- 1) A well pump was reported stolen on the 25th of October 2007. The incident occurred at a residential property on Lion Head Drive (runs north off of McWatty Road, just south of Pakenham) between 03:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the 25th.

Tay Valley Township:

- 1) A hydro pole located at a residential property on Otty Lake Side Road (runs south off of Scotch Line Road, west of Perth) was reported damaged on the 24th of October 2007. The yard sustained some damage as well, and broken glass was left behind from an unknown vehicle. The incident occurred during daylight hours on the 24th.
- 2) A trailer was reported broken into on the 28th of October 2007. Entry was made through a window at which time several items including a television, DVD player and a home theatre system and alcohol were stolen. The incident occurred on Bass Bay (runs off of Miners Point Road near Murphy's Point Park, Big Rideau Lake).
