



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE **04 April 2008**

Almonte:

No incidents to report.

Beckwith Township:

No incidents to report.

Carleton Place:

- 1) A black 2008 Chevy Silverado pickup truck was reported stolen from a car dealership located on McNeely Avenue. The truck is believed to have been stolen between the 29th and 31st of March 2008. The vehicle has tinted windows and is a four door crew cab. Broken glass was left behind at the scene.
- 2) Three incidents of vehicles having been entered overnight were reported on the 31st of March 2008. Two of the incidents occurred on King Street where approximately \$20.00 cash was stolen from one of the vehicles. The third incident occurred on Rochester Street where approximately \$40.00 cash and several C.D's were reported stolen.
- 3) A wallet was reported stolen from an unlocked vehicle on the 01st of April 2008. The incident occurred at the Curling Club parking lot located on Patterson Cr.

Central Frontenac Township:

- 1) A hunting camp was reported broken into on the 31st of March 2008. The incident occurred on Cross Road in the vicinity of Armstrong Road, west of Sharbot Lake. A door was forced to gain entry at which time several items including a Honda generator, Husqvarna chainsaw, and a bear hide were stolen from the premises.
- 2) A suspicious person incident was reported to police on the 31st of March 2008 after footprints in the snow were observed at a residential property by the property owner. The incident occurred on Road 38, south of Sharbot Lake in the vicinity of Wagner Road. Police later determined that a rear window had been forced at the residence and someone may have entered the home exiting by a door. No items were reported stolen. The exact time frame for when this occurred is not known however it is believed the incident occurred on the 29th of March 2008 between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

- 3) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 04th of April 2008 at 5:00 a.m. The incident occurred on MacPherson Road (runs north off of Bell Line Road, east of Road 509) in the vicinity of Bell Line Road. A vehicle was observed stopping on the roadway for a long period of time with its light off. Police subsequently attended and the occupants departed.

North Frontenac Township:

Drummond/North Elmsley Township:

- 1) The tire of a truck was reported set on fire on the 27th of March 2008. The incident occurred on Drummond Concession 2 in the vicinity of Drummond Concession 2A (runs east from Perth, occurred east of Richardson).

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) A S.U.V was reported stolen on the 30th of March 2008 from a residential property located on Anderson Road (runs east off of 2nd Concession Dalhousie, east of Poland) sometime overnight. The vehicle which was later located abandoned on the 2nd Concession Dalhousie is believed to have been stolen between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the 30th of March 2008.
- 2) Several vehicles were reported entered and items stolen on the 01st of April 2008. Police received four separate reports with three occurring on Princess Street and one occurring on Owen Street in the Village of Lanark. Multiple vehicles were entered with several items reported stolen, including keys, cell phone, cell phone charger, IPOD, and three jackets.
