



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
06 February 2008

Almonte:

- 1) Five Cadillac emblems were reported stolen off a Cadillac overnight on the 02nd of February 2008. The vehicle had been located at a residential property on King Street. In similar incidents two emblems were also reported stolen off a Mercedes overnight on the 02nd at a residential property on Almonte Street and in an earlier incident on the 30th of January 2008, three emblems off of a Cadillac were reported stolen overnight from a car located on Reserve Street. FYI and observation.

Beckwith Township:

No incidents to report.

Carleton Place:

- 1) A lamp post was reported vandalized overnight on the 01st of February 2008. The incident occurred at a residential property on Hughes Street.
- 2) A school bus parked just off of Beckwith Street at the RBC parking lot was discovered vandalized on the 04th of February 2008. The incident occurred between 6:00 p.m. and 10:15 p.m. on the 4th. The vandalism consisted of someone spraying the interior of the bus with the fire extinguisher that had been located on the bus. In addition a snowboard described as being black with sunflowers, with a white bottom, and red strap bindings was reported stolen from the bus.

Central Frontenac Township:

- 1) On the 02nd of February 2008 police received a report of vandalism to a vehicle located at a residential property on Road 38 at Tichborne. Police were advised that it appeared someone had poured a substance, possibly maple syrup into the gas tank of the vehicle which was now not operating properly. Unknown time frame for when exactly the incident occurred.
- 2) A red 1995 Jeep Cherokee reported stolen from the parking lot at the Sharbot Lake Medical Center on the 31st of January 2008 during daylight hours was later recovered abandoned in a field off of Road 38, south of Unity Road in Kingston on the 04th of February 2008. The plates which were removed from the vehicle AYJP595 Ontario are still outstanding as stolen.

Mississippi Mills Township:

- 1) A quantity of copper wire was reported stolen to police on the 30th of January 2008. The theft occurred from a business property located on Ramsay Concession 2A (runs through Highway 7, west of Carleton Place) between October 2007 and January 2008. In these types of thefts a vehicle is certainly required to transport the stolen property, therefore any suspicious vehicles seen at or near business properties, especially during “off” hours should be reported to police immediately if observed.

Tay Valley Township:

- 1) A green (camouflage) Polaris 500 A.T.V was reported stolen from a residential property on the 04th of February 2008. The incident occurred on Bolingbroke Road in the vicinity of Hanna Road and Little Silver Lake Road (runs south from Highway 7 at Maberly). The ATV had been stored in a garage when it was stolen. Unknown time frame for the theft.
