



**LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE**  
**30 January 2008**

**Almonte:**

No items to report.

**Beckwith Township:**

- 1) A residence located on Scotch Corners Road (runs south off of Hwy 7, west of Carleton Place) was reported broken into on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2008. The incident occurred between the 19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2008 when a door was forced to gain entry. Reported stolen was a television projector.
- 2) A make-shift trailer was reported stolen on the 29<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. The trailer was stolen between the 26<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of January 2008 after it had been left at the Park N Ride located at Highway 7 and Cemetery Side Road, east of Carleton Place after suffering a flat tire. When the owner returned to retrieve it on the 29<sup>th</sup> it was discovered stolen. The trailer is described as the box portion of a Chevy S10 red pickup truck with a white cap. At the time of the theft the trailer was plated with an Ontario license plate of D8843Z.

**Carleton Place:**

- 1) A suspicious person complaint was made to police on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2008 at approximately noon. A suspicious male was reported to have attended a residence in Carleton Place indicating he was selling apples. The offer was declined and the male left. He is described as being 50-60 years of age, heavy set and approximately 5' 10" in height. He had gray hair, and was wearing a plaid jacket and blue jeans, and operating a blue van.
- 2) On the 25<sup>th</sup> of January 2008 a business located on Bruce Crescent was reported broken into overnight. Reported stolen were approximately 25 batteries, and 10 radiators. A snow blower described as a red Craftsman with an 8 hp engine with tracks instead of wheels was also stolen. The theft is estimated at \$670.00.
- 3) A large "Jesus Is Alive" sign was reported stolen overnight on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. The sign had been located outside a church on Bridge Street in the vicinity of Morphy Street. The stolen item was 4X8 in size and had been bolted to a steel frame when it was taken.

### **Central Frontenac Township:**

- 1) A garage at a residential property was reported broken into on the 25<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. The incident took place between the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of January on Bordenwood Road (runs off of Richardson Road, north of Highway 7, north of Arden). A door was forced to gain entry; however upon checking the contents of the garage, no items were discovered stolen.
- 2) A garage at a residential property located on Road 38 just south of Parham was reported broken into on the 26<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. The incident occurred between the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of January 2008 when a window was forced to gain entry. Reported stolen was a 5 gallon red gas container containing approximately \$25.00 worth of gas. A similar incident was reported on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2008 regarding the theft of gas, when gas was reported stolen/siphoned from a vehicle at a residential property on Road 38 south of Parham.

### **North Frontenac Township:**

### **Drummond/North Elmsley Township:**

- 1) A mailbox was reported vandalized on the 29<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. The mailbox located at a residential property on Ferguson Falls Road (runs east off of Hwy 511, south of Lanark) was discovered damaged on the 29<sup>th</sup> when the door was found to have been ripped off and discarded on the roadway nearby.

### **Lanark Highlands Township:**

- 1) On the 27<sup>th</sup> of January 2008 at 10:20 p.m. the attempted theft of a tractor was reported to have occurred. The owner observed that someone had attempted to start the tractor when the lights were observed on. Upon checking the tractor no damage had occurred. The incident occurred at a residential property on the 7<sup>th</sup> Concession Dalhousie which runs south off of Watsons Corners Road, northeast of McDonalds Corners.

### **Montague Township:**

### **Mississippi Mills Township:**

- 1) The lodge located at a ski hill on Ski Hill Road, south of Pakenham was reported broken into on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2008. A window was forced to gain access, however no items were reported stolen.

**Tay Valley Township:**

- 1) Between 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on the 21<sup>st</sup> of January 2008 a garage at a business property located on Narrows Lock Road in the vicinity of Powers Road (runs south off of Scotch Line Road, west of Perth) was broken into. Entry was made through a window at which time an office was then entered. No items were reported stolen from inside. Diesel fuel however was reported stolen/siphoned from an outside tank on the property.
