Calls For Service: 417

Beckwith Township:

20 July – 4:00 a.m. – Highway #15 - report of a suspicious vehicle at the ATV business – officer attended, all okay – *good example of calling in suspicious activity*

21 July – Beckwith Township yard – two front tires removed from a stolen off of a Township dump truck – valued at \$275.00.

21 July – 3:25 p.m. – report of young people jumping off of Mississippi River bridge on Highway #7 – attended and removed young people

22 July – 8:30 a.m. – Jock Ridge Drive – report of home being struck with eggs

23 July – 5:00 p.m. – Highway #15 – report of 5 to 6 bears crossing the Highway – officer attended area, bears gone on arrival.
