Calls For Service: 390

Beckwith Township:

17 August – Kidd Road – report of mailbox and civic number theft over the weekend from a residence between Saturday and Sunday 10:30 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. No suspects.

19 August – McGregor Drive – two separate unlocked vehicles entered overnight – one rummaged through with nothing missing, and a brown leather folding wallet taken for the other.

19 August – Pine Ridge Drive – two unlocked vehicles entered overnight – stolen from inside were: lottery tickets.

20 August – Timberwood Drive – report of a trailer license plate being stolen from the trailer – license number F5176N.

3) 2008 Doberman Pinscher, 12 speed, pink/purple frame, stolen from inside a detached garage that was closed but unlocked – valued at \$2700.00

20 August – Bridge Street – attempt break and enter to Maple Leaf Dairy. Two males seen running up William Street from the scene – all dressed in black. Panel of front door removed, Robertson screwdriver left at the scene. No entry gained.
