



LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE
12 January 2009

Almonte:

No incidents to report.

Beckwith Township:

- 1) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 06th of January 2009 at approx. 08:30 a.m. after it was observed parked stationary near a school on Highway 15. Police attended and ascertained the identity of the occupant and determined the person was there for a legitimate reason. A great example of reporting suspicious activity! ☺
- 2) An outbuilding located at a residential property on Ashton Station Road, south of Prospect was reported broken into during the daylight hours on the 06th of January 2009. Entry was made by breaking a lock to the door at which time several items were stolen. The stolen items are as follows; 6 hp Evinrude boat motor with gas tank, Husquavarna 50 cc chain saw, red Homelite 20" bar chainsaw, large wrench set, stereo, whipper snipper, 4.5 pressure washer, Mastercraft socket set, and a red and yellow Honda Jiffy Split wood splitter. Due to the weight of the wood splitter it may have required two persons to carry it.

Carleton Place:

- 1) The front window of a residence was vandalized (broken) on the 06th of January 2009 at 12:45 a.m. when the occupants awoke to the sound of breaking glass. The incident occurred on Beckwith Street.
- 2) Several items were reported stolen from an unlocked garage on the 06th of January 2009. The incident took place at a residential property on Dunham Street. Reported stolen was a snow blower, gas can, and kayak paddles.
- 3) On the 06th of January 2009 a generator and a snow blower were reported stolen overnight from an unlocked shed at a residential property on Napoleon Street. The stolen items are described as a black 2007 Eastern Tools and Equipment TG7000 7kw gas generator, and a black Brute 11.5 TP-27 snow blower.
- 4) On the 06th of January 2009 the attempt theft of a snow blower overnight was reported to police. The incident occurred on Napoleon Street where it appeared the unlocked garage was entered and the snow blower moved. However due to a vehicle inside the garage the snow blower was unable to be moved outside. It is believed the above incidents are related.

- 5) A larger cooler located outside on a business property on Highway 7 in the vicinity of McNeely Avenue was reported damaged on the 08th of January 2009. It is believed the damage which may have been caused by a vehicle occurred January 1st 2009.
- 6) The bumper of a van was reported vandalized (dented) overnight on the 11th of January 2009. The incident occurred on Johnston Street.

Lanark Highlands Township:

- 1) Approximately 34 barn boards were reported stolen on the 05th of January 2009. The boards were removed from a barn situated on a property on Upper Perth Road in the vicinity of 10th Concession B Lanark, north of Ferguson's Falls. The boards which varied in length from 8 feet to 18 feet were removed from the east side of the barn which is not visible to the roadway. Due to tire tracks left in the snow it is believed the theft occurred fairly recently. It may be noted that two 4X4 pickup trucks were observed near the property on the 04th of January 2009 during the afternoon.

Montague Township:

Mississippi Mills Township:

- 1) A 31 yr-old male from McNab Township was charged with several offences after police responded to a report of a stolen snowmobile from a business property located on Highway 7 on the 08th of January 2009. The thief after making several attempts to steal machines eventually set off an alarm. A citizen started following the thief who abandoned the machine and fled on foot through the snow. He was tracked by police and eventually taken into custody.
- 2) A suspicious person report was made after a homeowner observed tracks in the snow leading to a window in their residence, and vehicle tracks in the driveway on the 08th of January 2009. No entry was made into the residence. This incident occurred at a residential property on Old Mill Lane in Appleton.

Tay Valley Township:

- 1) An Ingersoll Rand Compressor was reported stolen to police on the 06th of January 2009 after it was discovered stolen from a business property located on Highway 7 in the vicinity of Harper Road, west of Perth. The theft is believed to have occurred within the last few weeks. The stolen item is further described as having the numbers “15390” painted in black, and a bronze ½ inch tag with the number 25033 on one side. The compressor which is quite large would most likely have been transported on a trailer.
- 2) A residence located on Upper Scotch Line in the vicinity of Noonan Side Road, west of Perth was reported broken into on the 09th of January 2009. Entry was made via a window at which several items were stolen. Reported stolen; cream colored portable Webber BBQ with a black stand, Poulan Pro chainsaw model PP3516AUX, Toshiba 22 inch LCD television with built in DVD player model LV505C, Echo grass trimmer model #SRM 230 and approximately half a dozen tall beers – German brand. The time frame for the break and enter is believed to be between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the 09th of January 2009.
- 3) Two mailboxes located at Bolingbroke Road and Hanna Road (runs south off Hwy 7 at Maberly) were reported damaged overnight on the 10th of January 2009. It appears that both may have been struck by a vehicle.
