Monday 06 July – 13 July 2009: 385 Calls For Service

Beckwith Township:

12 July – 1:30 p.m. – officer observed northbound Dodge Charger at a fast rate of speed, clocked in excess of 150 km/h – 19 year old Carp man charged with Racing, 7 day license suspension and vehicle impoundment.

Carleton Place:

09 July – a red, Pro Tour Cougar bicycle was found at Centennial Park – off of Joseph Street. Stored at detachment

10 July – 2:00 a.m. - Officer on patrol located upturned mailboxes on Patterson Crescent – unable to upright due to size and weight – town employees contacted in the a.m. to rectify.

10 July – 2:30 a.m. – Barclay Street – Homeowner called police concerned two males were having a fist fight – police attended and discovered two friends goofing around and play fighting – No assault. Males warned re: noise and time of night. Good example of calling for investigative purposes.

10 July – 3:20 a.m. – Moffatt Street – Resident called re: a suspicious person. A male with dark clothing and white hat on wandering around – resident asked what he was doing, he stated he lived in the area. Police patrolled area and did not locate.

10 July – 3:50 a.m. – Joseph Street – male knocking on doors and taking off – male described as tall and wearing a white t-shirt. Area patrolled by four officers, male not located.

10 July 10:45 p.m. – Bridge Street – vehicle owner left his 2002 Pontiac Grand Prix running and went into residence for a few minutes, returned to discover his vehicle stolen. Vehicle located short time later in Municipal lot with damage to passenger tires and rims – no suspects
