



**LANARK COUNTY OPP NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UPDATE**  
**15 June 2009**

**Beckwith Township:**

- 1) An Ottawa Sun newspaper box at a residential property on McLachlin Road (south of Franktown) was discovered vandalized (set on fire) overnight on the 05<sup>th</sup> of June 2009.

**Carleton Place:**

- 1) Several solar lights and an ornamental light were reported stolen from outside a residential property on George Street on the 02<sup>nd</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred overnight.
- 2) On the 01<sup>st</sup> of June 2009 the tires of a van were reported vandalized (slashed) overnight. The incident occurred at a business property on Victoria Street.
- 3) On the 01<sup>st</sup> of June 2009 damage to a van door lock was reported having occurred overnight. The incident occurred at a residential property on MacArthur Avenue.
- 4) A bike was reported stolen on the 02<sup>nd</sup> of June 2009 after it was left unattended for a few minutes in an alleyway at a business property on Bridge Street. The stolen item is described as a black Shimano Serengeti bicycle and was locked at the time of the theft.
- 5) Gas was reported siphoned overnight on the 04<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 from a truck located on Charles Street.
- 6) A firecracker was reported thrown at a house on the 06<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at approximately 9:50 p.m. on Julian Street.
- 7) On the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 a bug-zapper was reported vandalized overnight. The incident occurred at a residential property on Barclay Street where the item was removed from a fence and later located broken in the nearby park.
- 8) Three residences on Frank Street were reported "egged" overnight on the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009.
- 9) Flowers were reported damaged overnight on the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at various business premises on Bridge Street.
- 10) A flower pot was reported vandalized overnight (broken) on the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at a residential property on Mississippi Road.

- 11) Three outdoor moon ray lights were reported stolen overnight on the 08<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at a residential property on Mississippi Road.
- 12) On the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 a car was reported stopping at a residence on Charlotte Street at which time several youth sprayed the inside of a car at this location with a fire extinguisher. On the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 a similar incident occurred on Flora Street at which time two males were apprehended. Both are charged with mischief.
- 13) Plants were torn out of a planter and a hanging basket of flowers were vandalized at two business properties located on Bridge Street. The incident occurred overnight and was reported on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2009.
- 14) A large cast iron planter filled with flowers was reported stolen from a residential property overnight on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred on Emily Street.
- 15) A bicycle was reported stolen overnight on the 13<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at a residential property on Morris Street. The stolen item is described as a woman's bicycle, purple and gray in color.
- 16) A garage window was reported vandalized on the 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 after it was discovered broken by a rock. The incident occurred at a residential property on Franktown Road between 01:00 a.m. and 06:00 a.m.

**Central Frontenac Township:**

Marine Update: Long Lake was patrolled on the 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. Three boaters were charged with various equipment offences (no life jackets etc.).

**Lanark Highlands Township:**

- 1) The rear window of a passenger car was reported vandalized (broken) on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred between 4:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. while the vehicle was parked unattended on George Street in the Village of Lanark.

**Montague Township:**

- 1) A pickup truck reported stolen in the previous Neighbourhood Watch Update from a residential property between the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of May 2009 on Jubilee Street (at Smiths Falls town limits) has been located. The truck was located in the Ottawa area.
- 2) Five mailboxes were reported vandalized and several newspaper boxes pushed over on the 02<sup>nd</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at Rideau River Road and Boat Launch Road, southwest of Merrickville.

- 3) A BBQ was reported stolen from a carport on the 05<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred between 12:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the 05<sup>th</sup> at a residential property on Roger Stevens Drive in the vicinity of Rosedale Road S, east of Smiths Falls.
- 4) A mailbox was reported burnt overnight on the 05<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at a residential property on Nolan's Road in the vicinity of Rosedale Road N, northeast of Smiths Falls.

**Town of Mississippi Mills:**

- 1) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 05<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 after it was observed for a period of time sitting stationary on Ramsay Concession 7B in the vicinity of Clayton Road, west of Almonte. Police attended identifying an occupant who was found to be sleeping in the vehicle.
- 2) A GMC Jimmy was reported stolen overnight on the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 from a residential property on Water Street in Almonte. The vehicle was later recovered on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 in the Ottawa area.
- 3) On the 08<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 several exterior walls at the Almonte High School were discovered vandalized with spray paint. The incident occurred over the weekend between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of June 2009.
- 4) A suspicious vehicle was reported to police on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at approximately 4:40 p.m. after a male operating a vehicle described as a gray four door passenger car was observed driving slowly on Tait McKenzie Street in Almonte. The man appeared to be video taping. FYI and observation.

**Tay Valley Township:**

- 1) A storage shed was reported broken into on the 06<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at a residential property located on Sunset Ridge (Otty Lake), southwest of Perth. Reported stolen was a Dewalt table saw and a drill. The incident occurred between October 01<sup>st</sup> 2008 and June 5<sup>th</sup> 2009.
- 2) An attempt break and enter was reported on the 07<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. The incident occurred at the town hall located on Maberly Elphin Road between 01:00 a.m. and 07:45 a.m. Damage was noted at two windows and a door however entry was not gained.
- 3) A break and enter to an outbuilding located at the Maberly Fairgrounds on Bolingbroke Road was reported on the 09<sup>th</sup> of June 2009. Reported stolen were four plastic storage bins white in color with blue lids. The bins contained plates, napkins, salt and pepper, coffee maker, soft drinks and a kettle. A lock was tampered with to gain entry.
