**BY-LAW NO. 2010-1038**

**A BY-LAW TO SUBMIT A QUESTION TO ELECTORS  
(QUESTION ON THE BALLOT)**

---

**WHEREAS**, Section 8 of the *Elections Act, 1996*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law to submit to its electors, subject to section 8.1, a question not authorized by law but within the council's jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS**, the question concerns a matter within the jurisdiction of the municipality; is clear, concise and natural and is capable of being answered in the affirmative or the negative and the only permitted answers to the question are "yes" or "no";

**AND WHEREAS**, a public meeting was held on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 to consider the matter;

**AND WHEREAS**, a notice was provided to the public and the Minister on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 of Council's intention to pass this by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council of the Township of Lanark Highlands deems that the requirements of section 8.1 have been met;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Lanark Highlands enacts as follows:

**1. GENERAL REGULATIONS**

1.1 **THAT**, the question to appear on the ballot to electors for the 2010 Municipal Election be as follows:

*"Do you agree that the Deputy Mayor should be elected by general vote?"*

**2. ULTRA VIRES**

Should any sections of this by-law, including any section or part of any schedules attached hereto, be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be ultra vires, the remaining sections shall nevertheless remain valid and binding.
