### Containers



*Containers can be mixed together, but must be kept separate from paper*

- ✓ All plastic bottles and jugs with recycling symbols



- ✓ Aluminum plates and cans
- ✓ Cardboard cans (frozen juice, peanuts, hot chocolate, etc.)
- ✓ Cartons (milk and juice)
- ✓ Coffee cup lids (plastic)
- ✓ Drink boxes
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Empty, dry paint cans (lids removed)
- ✓ Non-refundable glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- ✓ Frozen juice cans (with metal lids)
- ✓ Juice boxes
- ✓ Plastic bags: bread, milk, frozen food and grocery (stuff plastic bags into another plastic bag and tie)
- ✓ Plastic cookie/lunchable/muffin trays
- ✓ Steel cans
- ✓ Styrofoam products (plates, cups, meat trays, egg cartons, packaging)
- ✓ Yogurt/pudding/applesauce cups



### Paper



*Paper can be mixed together, but must be kept separate from containers*

- ✓ Boxboard (cereal, tissue, cracker)
- ✓ Brown paper bags
- ✓ Catalogues and magazines
- ✓ Computer paper
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard
- ✓ File folders
- ✓ Frozen food boxes
- ✓ Greeting cards
- ✓ Hard cover books (covers and bindings removed)
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Newspaper and flyers
- ✓ Paper towel/toilet paper rolls (empty)
- ✓ Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag
- ✓ Soft cover books
- ✓ Wrapping and tissue paper
- ✓ Writing paper and envelopes



#### What NOT to Recycle

*The following items cannot be recycled and must be placed in your garbage.*

- ✗ Blister plastic packaging
- ✗ Broken window glass & ceramic dishes
- ✗ Diapers
- ✗ Cat litter and animal feces
- ✗ Chip and candy wrappers
- ✗ Plastic film wrap (shrink wrap)
- ✗ Used motor oil containers



#### DID YOU KNOW?

Recycling in Lanark Highlands is easy! There are two streams: fibre goes in one box (mixed paper & cardboard), containers in another (glass, plastic, metal.)
