**BY-LAW NO. 2000-182**

**BEING A BYLAW TO SET FINES UNDER  
THE PROVINCIAL OFFENCES ACT  
And TO AMEND SEVERAL OTHER BYLAWS**

---

**WHEREAS** Bylaws 2000-114, Bylaw 2000-126, Bylaw 2000-127 and Bylaw 2000-144 require amendments to comply with the wording required under the Provincial Offences Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Bylaws 2000-113, 2000-114, 2000-126, 2000-127 and 2000-144 require a set fine schedule;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Lanark Highlands ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

**1/ THAT** Bylaw No. 2000-114 Section 5) PENALTY be deleted and replaced with the following:

**5) PENALTY**

Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.

**2/ THAT** Bylaw No. 2000-126 Section 5. be deleted and replaced with the following:

**5) PENALTY**

Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.

**3/ THAT** Bylaw No. 2000-127 Section 3. be deleted and replaced with the following:

**3) PENALTY**

Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.

**4/ THAT** Bylaw No. 2000-144 Section 3. be deleted and replaced with the following:

**3) PENALTY**

Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.
