Following the Sewer and Water Public Meeting held on October 26th, 2009, a delegation of Lanark Village residents submitted a list of questions to Council regarding a proposed change (Addendum) to the Environmental Study Report (ESR) approved in 2008 that proposes a different sewage treatment system than the one initially decided on and described in the original ESR.

Written responses to those questions were provided by the Council in December 2009, at which time the delegation requested a further meeting to review those questions and answers together with other arising queries.

In addition to Councillors and Township Staff, this public meeting will include a panel made up of representatives from the office of the Medical Officer of Health, the Ministry of the Environment, and Northern Watertek Corporation (the designer of the treatment system being proposed), who will answer questions that are within their areas of expertise.

Although open to all citizens, residents of Lanark Village are especially encouraged to attend.
