



ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM

What is the Adopt-A-Road Program? It is a program that has been established where groups can enter into an agreement with Lanark Highlands to volunteer to assist in providing a cleaner environment and more scenic Township Road System by completing approved activities.

The adoption may include various combinations of the following activities: litter pick up, spotting and reporting invasive plants and noxious weeds, hand pulling/spading of invasive plants and noxious weeds, accelerated mowing and landscape planting.
