BY-LAW NO. 2018-1514

A BY-LAW TO DELEGATE CERTAIN DUTIES DURING THE RESTRICTED ACTS AFTER NOMINATION DAY PERIOD

WHEREAS Section 23.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25. authorizes Council to delegate its powers and duties;

AND WHEREAS Section 275 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25. restricts council from taking certain acts after nomination day or the election of a new council, depending on the results of the nominations or election;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to delegate certain duties during the period that Council may be restricted in its actions under Section 275 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25;

Now Therefore the Council of The Township of Lanark Highlands enacts as follows:

- 1. For all elections following passage of this By-law, in the event that the new council will include less than three-quarters of the members of the outgoing council: (a) based on the nominations made after the close of nominations, or (b) based on the results of the election, the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO)/Clerk/Deputy Treasurer or Clerk Administrator/Deputy Treasurer is hereby delegated the authority to:
 - a. approve any expenditures and incur any liabilities on behalf of the Township in excess of \$50,000.00;
 - execute any contracts on behalf of the Township;
 - c.dispose or acquire real or personal property with a value in excess of \$50,000.00;
 - d. appoint or remove from office any officer of the Township; and
 - e. hire or dismiss any employee of the Township;

during any period that Council is restricted from taking those acts under Section 275 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25. The Chief Administrative

Officer (CAO)/Clerk/Deputy Treasurer or Clerk Administrator/Deputy Treasurer is required to report to Council in the first quarter of the following year regarding any exercise of this delegated authority.

- 2. In the event of a conflict between any Township of Lanark Highlands by-law, this by- law is operative.
- 3. The delegations in this bylaw are subject to any restrictions on such delegation under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 or any other Act.

2. BY-LAW REPEALED

2.1 All by-laws or parts thereof and resolutions passed prior to this by-law which are in contravention of any terms of this by-law are hereby rescinded.
