REGULATIONS AND LAWS

WITHDRAWAL




Location

Description of Current Conditions





The warning track is overgrown with grass. Infield skin installation and grading is needed.





Scope of Work

The work covered under this contract includes the supply and delivery of all labour, material and equipment necessary for the reconstruction of the infield. The work includes but is not limited to the following general items, site excavation, subgrade preparation, find grading to improve drainage, installation of infield material and any sod/topsoil and seed as required. This work requires that home plate be removed and reset according to the final grade established as a result of the construction.


Existing General Dimensions:




Current estimated dimensions of the ball diamond are identified above. The ball diamond fencing will be repaired this spring, the backstop will be moved up 20 ft. Accurate field layout and measurement is required.

Proposed Work (General Requirements):

Not Required: Coach's Box and On-Deck Circles





Infield, Basepaths & Home Plate Area Replacement:

- 1) Cut edge of infield to field dimensions provided. Include some effort for cutting additional 1.5m beyond infield areas to match grade if required.
- 2) Remove 6" of existing material. Stockpile/dispose of at west diamond (see site map).
- 3) Compact infield subgrade.
- 4) Supply and install 6" of infield mix.
 - ➤ Infield Mix shall meet the following mechanical analysis:
 - Free of any stones greater than ¼" in diameter
 - Soil Classification Range:

Total Sand (1.0-0.05 mm) 75% - 85%			
Medium Sand (0.5-0.25 mm)	. 50% of total sand		
Silt (0.05-0.0002 mm)	10% - 15%		
Clay (less than 0.002 mm)	>10%		
Silt/Clay Ratio	0.5-1.0		
Recommended Product: Washington Ball Mix an engineered blend of sand,			
baked clay and virgin clay.			

- 5) Finish grade of infield, complete sod/soil and seed restoration.
 - Turf damage shall be minimized
 - If damage to turf areas is unavoidable, contractor to notify Township in advance and contractor shall plan appropriately for resinstatement at the approval of the Township.

- Installation of new material must meet existing surrounding grade and be in keeping with existing profile.
- Staging and field access shall be approved by the Township.
- Contractor to reinstate bases, home plate and any appurtenances disturbed during the project.
